

What's the Difference? The difference between trees and shrubs is that of size. Trees are generally defined as a woody plant with only one erect stem at least three inches in diameter at four and a half feet above the ground, and growing to a height over thirteen feet. A shrub is any woody plant smaller than that. A general rule of thumb is: if you can walk under it, it's a tree; if you have to walk around it, it's a shrub.

Invasive Species. Invasive plants are one of the greatest threats to New Jersey's biodiversity. In New Jersey, 94 invasive plants have been identified. Many invasive species out-compete important native species which are essential for food and cover to native wildlife. Thus, when invasive plants invade a habitat we lose not just our native plants; we also lose the animals which depend on them for food and shelter. Learning to identify and eradicate invasive plants is an essential task for land managers as well as backyard gardeners.
